## NEW RANGE OF LTM MOTOR CONTROLLERS

We showed a new range of controllers at Plasa 2005. We have built units with up to 42 channels, in both Direct Control (DC) and Low Voltage (LV) Control for the Lodestar® and other hoists.

The standard units are enclosed in flight cases but we have also built wall mounted controllers in industrial type panels and rack mountable units for clients to put into their own flight cases.

Enquiries will be welcomed.

We can generally turn special controllers around within seven days, with standard 4, 6, 8 and 12 channel available from stock. Both 415V-3Ph-50Hz and 220V-1Ph-50Hz power supply are available.



## DIRECT CONTROL PROSTARS®

Upon investigation, we discovered that the standard 415V-3Ph-50Hz Prostar can be converted to Direct Control (DC – with a power cable only) and we have already had three orders, two for four units and one for twelve units which were made up from stock hoists. If you need Direct Control (DC) Prostars, please consult us; the delivery should be good.
